


#### **2016** Herd Performance


- Farm Size 76 ha (MP) 250 cows: Overall 2.5 LU/ha
- 1.48 million litres: 5900 litres protein 3.75% fat 4.48%
- 500 Kg MS/cow: 1,650 kg MS/ MP ha
- 16.8 ton grass grown: 650 kg meal
- Average milk price 30.36 c/litre
- Herd EBI 120 Xbred herd
- 9% empty after 9.5 weeks





## **Calving protocol**



1. Pick out near calving

2. Night time calver

3. Pooled colostrum

## Calf health management

- Dehorned and vaccinated for blackleg
- Intranasal (Rsvp Pi3) day 9
- Rotavirus, Coccidiosis, Cryptosporidiosis
- Cydectin la at turnout
- 140 days later zearl 8 weeks product
- Bovipast



Calve management is a challenge every year

#### Labour

- Be organised before calving starts
  - Evaluate what labour is on the farm and define roles
  - Calving 3 full time + w/end student + 12 week student
  - Milked OAD for 3 weeks no effect on solids
  - Rest of year 3 full time
- Days off and enough sleep (7 hours/ night) vital even in peak calving
